HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

- Began study of performance based systems in late 2008.
- Original research team worked with Pennsylvania and Indiana and visited sites.
- NYSRA presentation on concept in 2008
- Feed back led to more extensive research
- Scientific measurement agreed upon
- Survey disseminated & completed by mid 2010.
- APSE presentation in April 2011

DUAL PURPOSE

To <u>evaluate</u> the current Fee for Service (SE) Supported Employment Program in terms of effectiveness, cost and time utilization per service area.

II. To assist in the <u>creation</u> of a new outcome based SE design that will improve employment for disabled consumers while supplying a realistic funding process for providers and ACCES-VR.

METHODOLOGY

- I. Provider Survey & Quantitative
- Data Analysis (including trial run)
- II. Qualitative Interviews (Six states: AL, IN, PA, MD, OK, CA)

- IV. Academic Research
- V. Triangulation of Data: NYISER, ACCES-VR, & Survey (10/2007-9/2009)

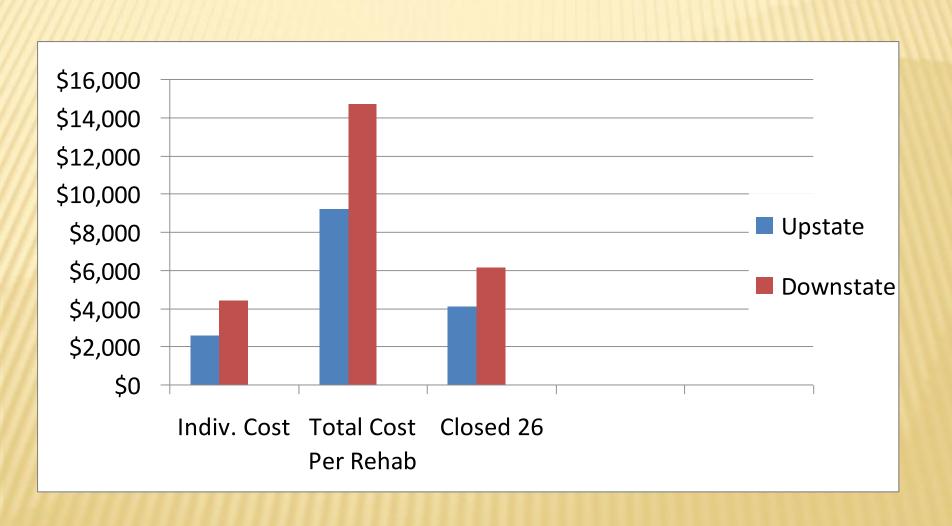

KEY RESULTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

- Average hours utilized (63-68)
- Percentage of individuals rehabbed from total referrals: 28%
- Percentage of individuals reached 90 day from those hired 59%
- Average cost per consumer studied in 3 formats to develop a base rate:
- Ave cost per consumer in SE (Total \$/Consumer)
- Ave cost per rehab. (total billing/total rehabs)
- Ave cost of rehab closures (billing on closed cases only)

KEY RESULTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

SIMULATIONS

- Simulations Provide Valid Comparisons for Rate Development
- Most Recent Simulation Runs:

Upstate: + 9.00 to + 18.5% change in funding

Downstate: - 1.96 to + .22 % change in funding

- Overall Spending consistent with survey period
- Size Does Not Matter (Of Contract)

STATE RESEARCH (5 states, rural and urban, provider & agency contacts)

- Increase in rehabilitations ranged from 3-25% across states
- Provider growth vs. loss of providers
- * High levels of satisfaction from all stakeholders
- Stable budgets & reduced cost per outcomes
- Unique methods for working with special populations & enclaves
- Oklahoma email

KEY RESULTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Oklahoma Provider Satisfaction Survey

- Time on waiting list reduced by 50%
- Time to job placement reduced by 18%
- Paperwork reduced by 33%
- Data entry reduced by 98%
- Cost per closure decreased 25%
- Better accountability 83%
- Chose Milestone over Fee- for- service 80%

RESULTS CONTINUED....

Extended Services

- 1. Ave. days to stabilization: 86-107 range
- 2. Date of documentation & definition differs per provider
- 3. Inconsistency on utilization
- 4. Potential for change in the concept of stabilization

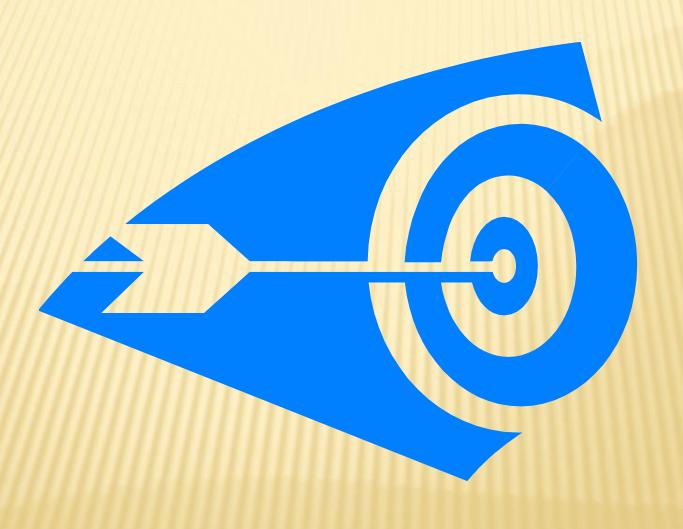

PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

Details, Braiding, & Development

- New simulations with new draft designs based upon feed back
- Additional follow up with other states if needed
- Define multiple placements, reauthorizations, 5 day/3 milestone, hours bonus, wages bonus, reduce authorization, training for agency staff & provider staff
- Coordination & development with State partners, leadership groups
- UCS /SE RFP combination and alignment of services
- Potential changes in reporting and planning process
- Review of new SE P&P and possible amendments
- Outline transition period from hourly to milestone

MILESTONE MODEL CALCULATOR

7800 Baserate Model assuming 10% increase in placements - Program with 103 SE Consumers (Current Revenue=\$350,658)

Using a case baserate of \$6000 and assuming a 10% increase in successful closures, the upstate region shows a potential per program gain in revenue of about 9% while downstate loses about 28%.

Using a case baserate of \$6000 but assuming a 25% increase in successful closure, upstate programs gain about 18% while downstate loses about 20%.

Assuming the same closure rate but boosting the downstate baserate by a 30% cost of living adjustment results in an outcome where downstate breaks about even.
