## REHABILITATION OUNCEL

## **Council Functions**

34 Code Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 361.17 (h)

- Review, analyze, and advise regarding Vocational Rehabilitation's (VR) performance related to:
  - Eligibility
  - Order Of Selection (OOS)
  - Extent, scope and effectiveness of VR
    - Functions performed by State agencies that affect the ability of individuals with disabilities to achieve employment outcomes.
- 2. In partnership with VR:
  - Develop, agree to, and review State goals and priorities
  - Evaluate the effectiveness of the VR program
  - Submit reports to the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) Commissioner.
- Advise the Department of Education (DOE) and VR regarding FRC activities and assist in the preparation of:
  - The state plan
  - · Amendments to the plan
  - Applications
  - Reports
  - Needs assessments, and
  - Evaluations.
- 4. Review and analyze the effectiveness of, and consumer satisfaction with:
  - The functions of VR
  - The services provided by VR and other entities
  - Employment outcomes achieved by customers.
- 5. Prepare and submit an Annual Report to the Governor, RSA and the public on the status of VR programs.
- 6. Coordinate FRC activities with the:
  - Florida Independent Living Council (FILC)
  - Advisory Panel of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)
  - Florida Developmental Disabilities Council
  - Florida Mental Health Council
  - Workforce Florida, Inc (WFI).
- 7. Provide for coordination and the working relationships between VR, FILC and Idependent Living Centers (ILCs) in the State.
- 8. Perform other functions as the Council determines appropriate and comparable to other actions, provided they are consistent with Title I of the Rehabilitation Act and implementing regulations.
